Charles Shey Wiysonge is the Director of Cochrane South Africa, an Extraordinary Professor of Global Health at Stellenbosch University, and an Honorary Professor of Epidemiology and Biostatistics at the University of Cape Town. His previous appointments include Deputy Director of the Centre for Evidence-based Health Care at Stellenbosch University; Project Manager of the Vaccines for Africa Initiative and Chief Research Officer at the University of Cape Town; Chief Research Officer at the Joint United Nations Programme on HIV/AIDS in Geneva; Deputy Permanent Secretary in the Central Technical Group in charge of the Expanded Programme on Immunisation in Cameroon; and Medical Epidemiologist at the Pasteur Centre of Cameroon in Yaoundé. Professor Wiysonge sits on multiple high-ranking scientific and policy advisory bodies on research, vaccination, and evidence-based health Care at national, continental, and global levels. He has a B2 rating from the National Research Foundation of South Africa, and his current research is devoted to understanding vaccination barriers and finding tailored evidence-based solutions for these barriers.
